TIMELINE

Orientation – Saturday, December 8, 2018; Location: Edmonds Community College

12:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Format: Welcome, networking lunch provided. Guest speakers, service guidelines, team building activities. During our orientation, we match agendas by giving an overview of expected learning outcomes, expectations and procedures, including:
